



Impossible Box

Materials:

Cardstock 20cm x 25.5cm

Double sided tape (strong)

Designer Series Paper, Ribbon and embellishments

1. Take your cardstock and along the 20cm side (short side) score at 2cm, 5cm, 8cm, and 14cm.
2. Turn your cardstock a quarter turn to the left (long side) and score at 6cm, 12cm, 18cm, and 24cm.
3. On the 5cm score line make a mark 3cm down in each square. Cut out the triangles as shown on your sheet.
4. Cut any solid lines with your craft knife and then run over all score lines with your bone folder.
5. Stamp any decoration you wish to on your box.
6. Turn your box lid edge down and score.
7. Fold up the bottom flaps of your box and stick down with tape. These may need trimming slightly.
8. Close the box by gently pushing down on the lid. This will be a very tight fit so just ease it gently and then stick down with your tape.
9. Decorate and embellish as required.

Just a quick note before assembling your box. DO NOT stick down the tab on the lid section before you have closed the box as you may have to adjust slightly to make it fit. (Don't ask me how I know this.....)
